Reduce the cost of your education with an Annual Scholarship

ASSP Four Corners Chapter Scholarship

This Scholarships shall be awarded to a Student meeting the following criteria:

- Enrolled as a full time or part time student
- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Must be a resident of San Juan County.
- Preference given to a student pursuing in the Occupational Health & Safety.

Rod Troxell Memorial Scholarship

The foundation shall establish the ASSP Four Corners Chapter Memorial Scholarship Fund. The fund shall be utilized to provide undergraduate scholarships for one or more selected student(s) attending San Juan College including, but not limited to the payment of tuition and fees, room and board, books and costs of education of the selected student(s). A student who is a recipient of a scholarship and must be making satisfactory progress toward obtaining a degree in the area of study, in accordance with the process set in place by San Juan College.

The number, dollar amount of each scholarship, the criteria for award of a scholarship from the fund and the selection of the student to receive scholarships from the Fund shall be determined and awarded by San Juan College upon such criteria and following such award process as San Juan College shall establish, in its sole discretion, except:

ASSP requests the following criteria:

- Student pursuing An Associates Degree in Safety in the School of Energy.
- Full-time or Part-time students
- Priority given to residents of San Juan County
