Since 1990, the [ASSP Foundation](#) has awarded millions of dollars in scholarships to students beginning their studies in occupational safety seeking to continue their education. Scholarships are available to students pursuing occupational safety and health (OSH) and closely related degrees both at the undergraduate and graduate level.

How to Apply for a Scholarship

Students enrolled in OSH-related majors and meeting basic criteria are eligible to apply for ASSP Foundation scholarships.

ASSP Four Corners Chapter Rod Troxell Memorial Scholarship

This Scholarships shall be awarded to a student *that* meets the following criteria

- Enrolled as a full time or part time student
- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Must be a resident of San Juan County.
- Preference given to a student pursuing an Occupational Health & Safety Certificate or Degree.
